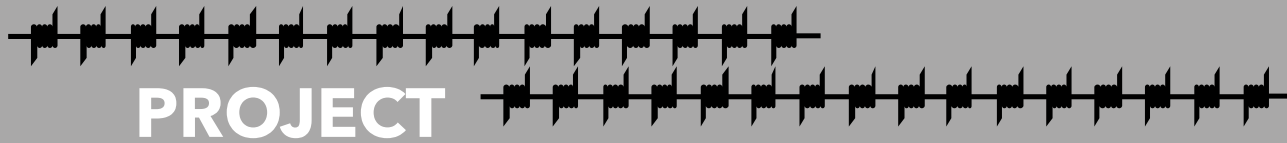
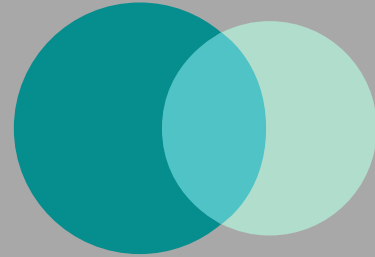

**We have an open door to reach Muslims for Christ like never before in our lifetime.**

Due to the ongoing conflict in the Middle East more than eleven million people—have been killed or forced to flee their homes.

Over 6 million of these refugees are living in Turkey and Jordan. These nations have opened their doors to the refugees, but are now at the breaking point, as the civil war in Syria has gone on for more than nine years.

The New Exodus Project is a collaboration between the SoCal Network and strategic partners who will endeavor to make a Kingdom impact in this often neglected region of the world.

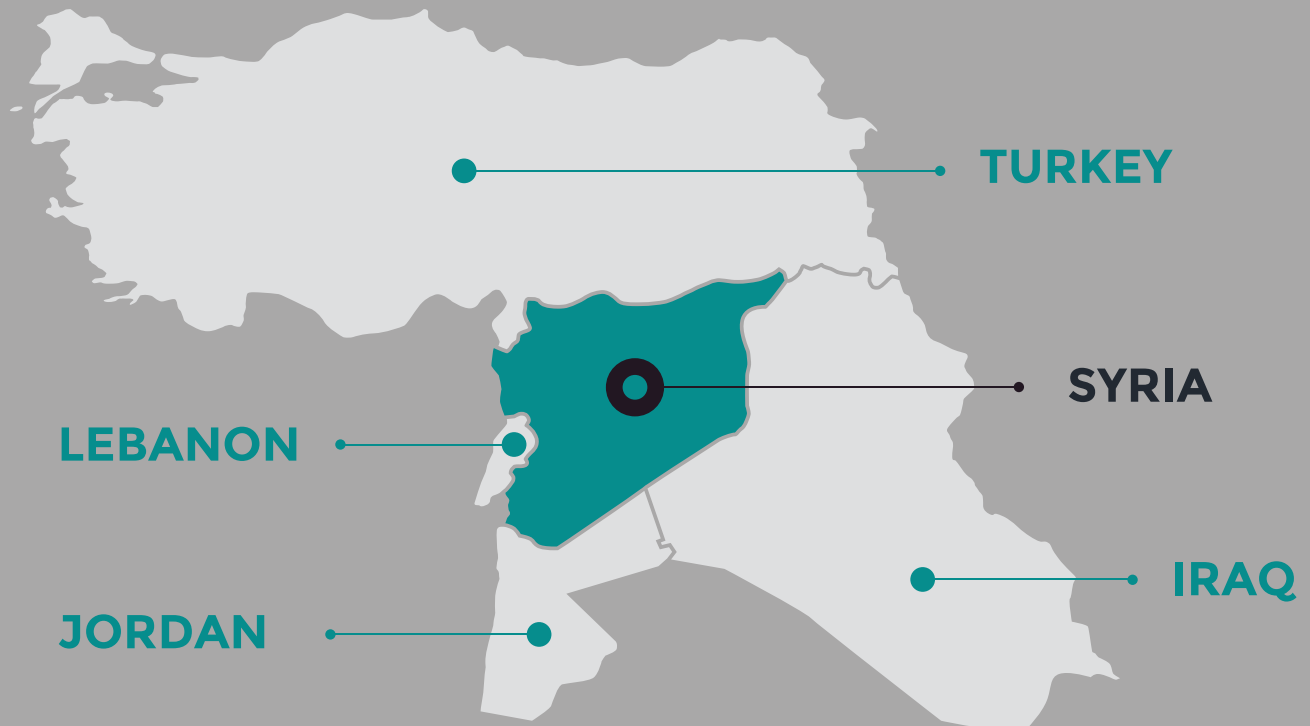
## Amman, Jordan

Ankara is the capital of Turkey. Kym and his wife Lau, SoCal Network Strategic Partners, are planting house churches among the refugees from Syria, Iran, and Afghanistan. They provide critical supplies for people who are surviving day to day. Kym and his team have already planted 11 house churches. They are providing the hope of Jesus Christ to thousands of Muslim Refugees.

Joseph and his wife Myra are preparing to go into Syria the moment it opens to foreigners. In the meantime, they have opened a Refugee Center offering a safe place for Syrians to find the love of Jesus Christ.

Ibrahim and his wife Aida, pastor a Church for Refugees in the heart of Turkey's capital city. In partnership with one of the few Evangelical Churches in the nation, they have opened a Refugee Center offering practical help and job training for refugees. Many who visit the center are receiving Christ as their Savior.

Sonar Tufan is the director of a Shema Media Ministry. He is one of the few in his country that are Christ-followers. Shema's outreach coverage reaches not only the country of Turkey but also expands to Syria, Afghanistan, and many other Arabic and Farsi speaking nations with the Gospel. Sonar, a former Muslim with a powerful faith story of coming to Christ, is under constant threat for his life because of his boldness to proclaim the Gospel.

# Jordan

Jordan has a population of 10 million people, yet less than 3% are Christian. There are 1.3 million refugees living in this country, many of which live in government-run refugee camps.

Two of the SoCal Networks Strategic partners are Dikran and Ani. They pastor a healthy church of more than 400 former Muslims. There are 12 Assemblies of God churches in this country, and the ministry of their church continues to have an incredible impact reaching Jordanians and vulnerable refugees for Christ. As they show refugees the love of Jesus in tangible ways, many are finding Christ.
